He was the principal photographer for two histories of landscape and garden design, Nature Perfected: Gardens through History, published by Abbeville Press, and Grounds for Change: Major Gardens of the Twentieth Century, published by The Bulfinch Press, projects which took him to some of the most beautiful gardens in this country and around the world. Inspired by these experiences, he designed a cottage garden incorporating a French style “potager,” and has documented his experiences in The Potager at Penrose Bungalow: An American Garden, a World of Ideas.
