Rebeka, twenty months old, is both fascinated with and afraid of going down the slide. She goes through the breath-taking motions of a toddler about to undertake a major first-time experience. She narrates her own story 3 years later from the mature perspective of a 4 y.o.

Screening time: 27 minutes

Rebeka, age nine, narrates her own impressions of her year in China attending an all Chinese school, becoming a Young Pioneer and getting caught in the middle of the student protests in the spring of 1989. She speaks thoughtfully about her experiences as an American girl living in a foreign culture.
